Belle's Star Receives Nomination

When Bonehead and Big Toby reappear and threaten Darcy, the girl's survival depends on the choice Belle makes.

Ms. Gotsch is the author of two award-winning adult novels. In 2007 she received the New Mexico Press Women's Communicator of Achievement Award and has been chosen to speak at the second annual New Mexico Women Authors' Book Festival.
